

2015 USATF SAN DIEGO-IMPERIAL ROAD CHAMPIONSHIP RULES:

- Participating 2015 championship races will be posted on the USATF San Diego-Imperial Association website at www.sdusatf.org. The list of qualifying races is subject to amendment according to the discretion of the Association Long Distance Running Committee.
- In order to be eligible for prize money and awards, participants **must be current members of the USATF San Diego-Imperial Association.**
- Participants may register for Association membership online at the www.sduastf.org using the “Apply for Membership” tab on the left..
- Participating championship races will require your Association number or an equivalent code that must be entered during the online registration process indicating that participants wish to be included in championship scoring. If participants do not include this number or code they will **not** be included in championship scoring.
- All age-graded awards will be determined post-race using the current **WMA** and **USATF** (<http://www.howardgrubb.co.uk/athletics/wmalookup15.html>) standards. Please allow up to the following Wednesday for official age-grade results to be calculated. - The Open age division is defined as ages 19-39 on race day.
- The Masters age division is defined as ages 40 & up on race day.

Road Championship Series Awards and Prize Money

OPEN MEN & WOMEN

1ST Place: \$200 & Gold Medal

2ND Place: \$125 & Silver Medal

3RD Place: \$75 & Bronze Medal

4TH Place: Official USATF merchandise worth up to \$50 & Bronze Medal

5TH - 10TH Places: Bronze Medal

MASTERS MEN & WOMEN

1ST Place Overall: \$50 & Gold Medal

1ST Place Age-Graded: \$50 & Gold Medal

Cash prizes will be awarded in the form of checks issued by the USATF San Diego-Imperial Association. Championship checks, awards, and medals will be awarded following the completion of the event at the designated awards area or the designated Association tent. Masters age-graded awards will be announced online via the Association website and Road Championship Facebook page. In the event an award recipient cannot pick up their award following an event an attempt will be made to contact them within seven (7) days to arrange for them to claim their award.
