

## SUPPLEMENTAL REGION 15 MEET INFORMATION June 20-22, 2014

Nearly 1500 athletes and 123 teams are registered to compete in the region's Junior Olympic Track & Field Championships held at Orange Glen High School and California State University San Marcos. The following information supplements the revised meet flyer (6/10/14) posted on the USATF San Diego Imperial Association's (USATF-SDI) website. It is intended to provide updated information in advance of the regional competition.

Recreational Vehicle (RV) Parking: A limited number of parking spaces will be available on Glenridge Road at Orange Glen High School. The RV parking area is in front of the school by a gully. Look for the administration building sign. USATF-SDI intends to have a person posted at the location to direct RV drivers to maximize the space. Only designated USATF-SDI RVs may park in the main school parking lot which is near the entrance to the track. Non-RV parking is available in the main school parking lot, (near the entrance to the stadium) and the staff parking lot which is on Glenridge Road just past the administration office and on the black top alongside Glenridge Road next to the gully.

<u>Canopies</u>: It is anticipated the school campus will be opened for teams/individuals to set up canopies beginning no earlier than 1:30PM on Friday, June 20<sup>th</sup>. Canopies that are placed in the bleachers must be secured on the top rows only. Canopies and pop up tents may be placed in the athlete's warm-up area and grass areas that surround the stadium.

<u>Implements</u>: USATF-SDI will provide all elements for the events with the exception of the hammer throw. Athletes who desire to use their own shot put or discus must have their implement weighed prior to competition. The official weigh station will be located in the southeast portion of the stadium (on the visitor's side). Weigh-in hours are from **7:00 a.m.** – **10:00 a.m. on Saturday and Sunday**.

<u>Coach's Corner</u>: USATF-SDI will staff a coach's corner to address any issues that may arise during the meet, including filing a protest. The location is the same as the weigh station. No coach, parent or spectator will be permitted in the infield area without express permission of the Meet Director or designee.

<u>Clerk of the Course Area:</u> No coaches, parents, or non-competing athletes will be allowed in the Clerk of the Course area. Coaches must provide instructions to their athlete(s) prior to them entering the clerking area.

<u>Track Spikes</u>: ONLY 3/16 needle spikes will be permitted on the track and runway surfaces excluding the regulation javelin. Shoes will be checked at the clerking area. Spikes will be available for purchase at the concession stand.
